

Adult Diploma Program: A VAL Conversation

* Guiding Practices

Will include Teaching Skills That Matter, A Vermont Portrait of an Adult Graduate, & Proficiency Based Graduation Requirements.

* Eligibility

You must be 16 or over, be a Vermont resident, and be unenrolled from school.

* Classes

Vermont Adult Learning continues to offer classes in subjects in which the Adult Diploma Program (ADP) requires proficiency.

* Dual Enrollment

Dual enrollment vouchers will be available (for CCV classes).

* Your Plan

Will be called an Adult Education Learning Plan, no longer a Personalized Learning Plan.

* Diplomas

Will be issued by participating schools.

* Requirements

The Agency of Education will determine the ADP graduation requirements, not the high school. They are still working on determining the requirements and have not given us a timeline for when they will be complete.

* GED

Is always an option.

* Unknowns

1. Students in ADP will graduate through one of the high schools participating in the program. We do not know which schools these will be yet but VAL has strong relationships with all Chittenden County schools and hopes that many of them will choose to participate.
2. The Agency of Education is still working on determining the graduation requirements.
3. We do not know when ADP will be launched.
